The Crab and Winkle Route

From Colne Community School along Church Road to Strangers Corner, down the lane past the playing fields on your left. A few hundred yards on the right is a footpath to All Saints Church. From the Church follow Moverons Lane to Alresford Creek and the Ford. On reaching the creek turn left and follow the footpath alongside of the creek to the site of the old railway swing bridge. Then follow the footpath along the sea wall to Batemans Tower, follow along the sea defence parallel to Promenade Way to the Community Centre and turn left on to Lower Park Road, passing the Railway Tavern on your right.

Continue along Lower Park Road and Turn left into Park Drive, continue along Park Drive to Chestnut Way (which is the second road on the right). This takes you to Marennes Crescent turn left and walk to the end of the road where you will join the footpath to Lodge Lane. This takes you to Church Road opposite the Colne Community School which is the finishing point of the walk.
